ROLL CALL

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES
Regular Meeting of February 20, 2001**

**APPROVAL OF PAYROLL AND CLAIMS
February 2001 – Second Half**

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Behymer to approve payroll and claims. Motion was seconded by Council Member Higdon.

GASOLINE TAX

The Clerk reported \$58,307.56 received in February of 2001 from the Department of Revenue for the gas tax, vehicle fee increases and vehicle sales, compared to last year's receipt of \$49,960.00 for the same period.

**PETER DANIELSONS – CITY ATTORNEY
Re: Ralls County Water District Easement**

City Attorney, Peter Danielsons stated that he had received a request from the Ralls County Water District. They are in the process of laying utility lines and this will involve going across the Municipal Airport property. The easement to do this work will be on the next Council agenda. They would like Council to decide whether to grant permission to proceed with work, or wait until the easement is presented at the next Council meeting on March 20, 2001.

Mayor Moloney made the motion to wait until we get the formal easement signed before starting work in this area. Council Member Behymer seconded the motion.

CITIZEN MAURICE SALIGHEH
Re: Handicap Parking Signage Request

Motion was made by Council Member Higdon to add Mr. Salegheh to the agenda in regards to his request. Motion was seconded by Council Member Behymer.

Mr. Saligheh addressed Council in regards to his wish for the City to place a handicap parking sign in front of his residence. He made the request on behalf of his son, who is wheelchair bound and needs access to a curb cut made in front of his residence for this purpose.

SERGEANT JIM HARK – HANNIBAL POLICE DEPARTMENT
Re: Bid for Dare Vehicle

Sargeant hark presented the bids received for purchase of a new Dare Vehicle. He recommended the bid be awarded to Murphy Motor Company in the amount of \$17,249.00. Although this bid was \$177.00 higher than the lowest bid, this package included the heavy-duty towing package that is needed on this vehicle and the lower bidder did not include this. Council Member Danforth made a motion to award the bid to Murphy Motor Company. Motion was seconded by Mayor Maloney.

Re: Bid for Radar Equipment

Sargeant Hark also presented bids received for radar equipment and explained that even though three bids were received, only one bid met the criteria for being opened. The one bid was from Kustom Signals for \$3,195.00. He recommended that Council award the bid to this company, since it was within the Police Department's budget for this item. Council Member Higdon made a motion to award the bid to Kustom Signals. Motion was seconded by Mayor Maloney.

The only bidder was from Maurice Capp who bid \$7,200.00 for 2001 and \$7,400 for 2002. She recommended that Council award the bid to Mr. Capp on this item. Council Member Danforth made motion to award bid to Maurice Capp. Motion was seconded by Mayor Maloney.
