SPECIAL RUN-OFF MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

City Clerk Angelica Vance explained that, in accordance with the provisions of the City Charter, when several candidates seek the same Council seat and no one receives a majority of the total votes cast, the two candidates receiving the most votes shall be opposing candidates for such office in a run-off election. In the recent Municipal Election that was held on April 6, 2010, this occurred. Run-off elections are to be held within two weeks following the original Municipal Election, according to the Charter, in this case, April 20, 2010. Vance presented Bill No. 10-011

regarding a run-off election for the Second Ward and Third Ward Council seats because candidates for neither Council seat received a majority vote. She requested Council approve this Bill with an emergency reading which would also approve the Special Run-off Election on that date.

During this election selection will be made for a Second Ward Council Member, with a term to expire April, 2013 and a Third Ward Council Member for a three-year unexpired term to expire April, 2012. Candidates for the Second Ward Council seat are Joe Lyng and Michael Dobson and the candidates for the Third Ward Council seat are Roy Que Ferrel Jr. and Lou Barta.
