ORDINANCE NO. 4669

EMERGENCY READING: 08-05-2014

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2014/2015 PAYROLL ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO THE PUBLIC WORKS AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS, (NO. 1)

WHEREAS, the city is in the process of reorganizing certain municipal functions to provide the same quality public service at less overall cost, and

WHEREAS, close examination of Public Works and Police Department operations yield opportunities for significant cost savings by modifying structures and staffing, and

WHEREAS, elimination of the city engineer position and subsequent assignment of those duties to other personnel requires an adjustment in Classification and pay, and

WHEREAS, the Hannibal Police Department can achieve nearly \$200,000 in net tangible savings by creating three (3) police officer positions previously eliminated; the creation of which will actually reduce, rather than increase the Police Department payroll line-item, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HANNIBAL, MISSOURI

SECTION ONE: The fiscal year 2014/2015 payroll ordinance is hereby amended to include the following changes:

SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall be read as an emergency measure pursuant to Chapter 2-20.3 of the City Charter entitled *Legislative Proceedings*, and therefore requires a 2/3 vote for passage.

SECTION THREE: All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: It hereby is declared to be the intention of the City Council that each and every part, portion and sub-portion of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, portion or sub-portion hereof and that the City Council intends to adopt each said part, portion or sub-portion separately and independently of any other part, portion or sub-portion. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, portions and sub-portions shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION FIVE: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and approval.
