AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF HANNIBAL CODE OF ORDINANCES, SECTIONS 16-155 RELATING TO *EXHIBITION OF DANGEROUS WEAPONS* AND 16-158 *PROMOTING PROSTITUTION* TO BRING THEM INTO COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF MISSOURI STATE SENATE BILL 491

WHEREAS, the legislature of the state of Missouri recently passed Senate Bill 491, an Omnibus Bill which made various changes to the rights of Cities to have certain ordinances on their books, and

WHEREAS, the Council has review the Ordinances of the City of Hannibal and have determined that certain ordinances need to be amended or deleted to remain in compliance with Missouri State Law.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council makes the following amendments to the ordinances of the City of Hannibal:

SECTION ONE: **Section Sec. 16-155. - Exhibition of dangerous weapons**, being in conflict with the new state law is hereby removed from the Ordinances of the City of Hannibal.

SECTION TWO: **Section 16-158. Promoting Prostitution**, being in conflict with the new state law is hereby removed from the Ordinances of the City of Hannibal.

SECTION THREE: It hereby is declared to be the intention of the City Council that each and every part, portion and sub-portion of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, portion or sub-portion hereof and that the City Council intends to adopt each said part, portion or sub-portion separately and independently of any other part, portion or sub-portion. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, portions and sub-portions shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, in so far as they conflict, are hereby repealed.


SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
