### **MEMORANDUM**

Re: Code Enforcement and Permitting Software Purchase

Date: October 31, 2019

Resolution 2231-19 amending the City Of Hannibal FY-2019-2020 (NO. 1) budget contained \$22,500 for the purchase of software to improve the data management capabilities related to code enforcement and building permitting.

With the assistance of the City's IT consultant, staff researched and tested various software products for usability, functionality, reporting, geographic information systems (GIS) integration and mobile use. After testing and consultation with the City's IT support provider, it was determined that the NASPO CLOUD SOLUTIONS-SHI provided the solution that best suits the City's needs.

This software will significantly assist in the processing of applications and complaints, the scheduling of inspections and tracking building permits by allowing for the complete record of a building permit or code enforcement property to be contained in one folder. Use of the software will enable staff to efficiently complete applications, inspections in the field and to print out completed permits and certificates before leaving a site.

### Additional benefits include:

- Documents (applications, complaints etc.) can be recalled at any time for effective updating and/or editing;
- Completed documents can be printed out directly from screen in any quantities;
- Mobile features allow forms to be completed on-site while inspectors are in field;
- Photographs can be saved with each inspection;
- Detailed notes can be included for each inspection;
- Previous inspections can be recalled for easy review;
- Internal tracking system allows easy identification of who performed each inspection and when information is added to the system;

- Automates the process of opening cases, scheduling inspections, recording violations and coordinating resolutions;
- Inspectors can view and add property ownership information, inspection results, photos, notices and violations from their mobile field devices, effectively allowing more time to interact with citizens and minimizing time in the office; and
- The history and mapping features allow for a comprehensive view of every recorded event surrounding a property inspection up to the present, as well as the ability to sort and group violations by specific location.

Subject: Delinquent Business Licenses

The businesses on the following list have still not acquired a current business license. We have sent out several reminders to them along with a note asking them to let us know if they are no longer doing business within the city limits of Hannibal. Debbie, in the Clerk's office, has also made numerous phone calls trying to get this resolved. We sent out certified letters (copy enclosed) on October 15<sup>th</sup> to all the businesses still listed as delinquent. At this time there are 53 still delinquent (this number will most likely change before the actual council meeting). They were given notice to be ready to appear and give just cause why they are still not licensed if they wish to appeal.

I will generate a new list for council after the close of the day November 5<sup>th</sup>. At the council meeting I will ask council to authorize the closure of any businesses by the chief of police (or his designee) that are still un-licensed at that time. With your authorization I will then send out notices on November 6<sup>th</sup> letting each business know and informing them of the 30 day appeal period. If nothing is resolved or appealed within that time I will submit the list of remaining businesses to the police department. They will check to make sure the business is no longer operating.

### Dear Business Owner:

Our records show that you are still delinquent on your business license. The payment for your business license for fiscal year 2019-2020 was due on June 30<sup>th</sup>. It is now 3 months delinquent. If we do not receive payment along with penalties and any necessary paperwork by November 5<sup>th</sup> we will request of the council at their meeting on that evening to begin the procedure to have the police close your business (they have the authority to chain and padlock the doors if necessary). Once council permission is given you will have 30 days to appeal the closure to the circuit court as provided under RSMO chapter 36 or to come to the city clerk's office to complete the process for license renewal. I am enclosing a copy of the City of Hannibal codebook referring to revocation/suspension of business licenses. Please refer to it to know your rights in this matter. \*\*Any payment made after Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> will need to include 8% more of the base license fee than is stated on the bill enclosed with this letter.

If this has to go before council there is a chance this information will appear in the newspaper or on television as council proceedings are open to the public and the media usually attend.

Please be aware that if you currently have a contract with the city we will have to look to other vendors as we are prohibited from contracting with an unlicensed business. If you plan to bid on a city project you will not be selected for the same reason. Also all city taxes (included with your county tax bill) must be paid before a license can be issued, in addition to a "certificate of no tax due" issued by the Missouri Dept. of Revenue if you have a state sales tax number.

We recently obtained quotes for the purchase of a new one-ton chassis cab, 4x4 truck (13,000 G.V.W.R.) with Knapheide bed and hoist package. We contacted four dealerships by using the state bid specs for medium duty trucks. Included in the quote was a trade-in value for the truck that will be replaced. The lowest total price of \$27,477 came from Poage CDJRF. I have attached a quote sheet to this memo.

The new Dodge Ram 3500 will replace a 2012 Dodge Ram 3500 that has nearly 90,000 miles on it. As stated, the 2012 will be traded into Poage CDJRF. We try to replace our one-ton trucks on a rotational basis to keep down our vehicle maintenance costs on higher mileage vehicles.

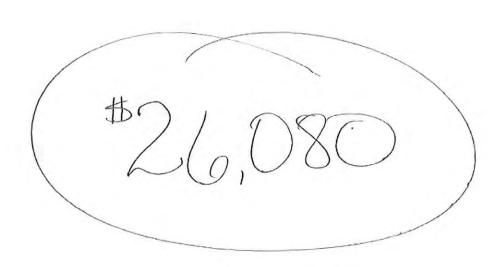

RE: Surplus Vehicles

We are requesting council permission to declare two vehicles, 2000 Sport Jeep Cherokee and 2002 Chevrolet Silverado 1500, as surplus property. We would then advertise the sale of the vehicles through the sealed bid process.

The Jeep has been in our fleet for nearly 20 years, and it has not been used by our staff for the last few years. We have other utility vehicles in our fleet, and the reliability of it on the road for everyday use has deemed it more of a maintenance issue than purposeful.

The Chevy has provided many years of service for our staff and seasonal workers. The vehicle is a utility type vehicle and serves a minimal purpose due to it being a 2x4 truck. The mileage is over 100k, so we don't want to incur continued maintenance on it to keep it operational. Also, in lieu of purchasing a new fleet vehicle, we plan to keep the particular truck being replaced. It is 4x4 with a snowplow package. It will become more useful as an additional vehicle in our fleet than the Chevy.

Parks and Recreation staff recommends council to declare the 2000 Sport Jeep Cherokee and 2002 Chevrolet Silverado as surplus property.

Over the last couple of months the City Manager, City Attorney and myself have been negotiating with American Cruise Lines on a riverfront/riverboat docking lease agreement. After a lot of discussion we feel comfortable proposing the following lease agreement between the City of Hannibal and American Cruise Lines.

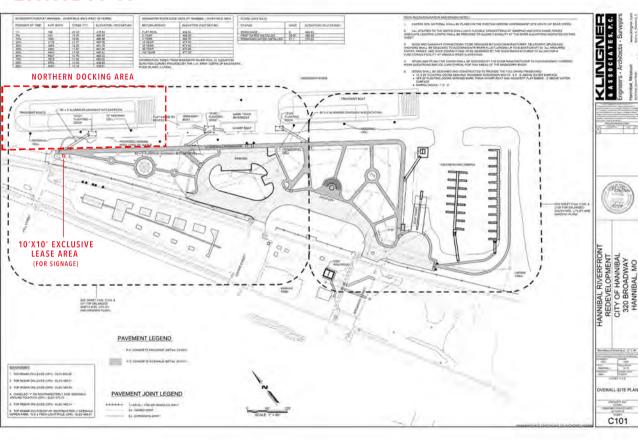
#### **Basic Lease Provisions Include:**

- 5 year lease, with 5 consecutive options to extend for 5 years each
- Periodic exclusive use of the Northern Docking Area
- Rent is \$1 per visit per passenger onboard the ship which shall increase every 5 years by 15% to a maximum of \$2 per visit per passenger
- A onetime capital contribution of \$25,000 plus periodic fees in the amount of \$10,000 upon the commencement of each five year renewal

The City of Hannibal is very excited to work with American Cruise Lines on a docking space for future riverboat excursions. Once the riverfront renovations are completed it will be a tremendous space for residents and tourists to spend time enjoying the beauty of the Mississippi River.

The Department of Public Works and City Manager recommend approval of the proposed riverfront lease agreement between the City of Hannibal and American Cruise Lines.

#### **GAC BUILDING CONSTRUCTION**

Since the last update provided, there has been a lot of visible activity on the GAC Facility at the Water Treatment Plant. The subcontractors installed all of the below slab piping and conduit that will facilitate the installation of planned equipment in the future. The concrete floor slab was able to be poured, followed by the remaining concrete walls and equipment pads for the GAC vessels. After the equipment pads obtained the necessary strength, the contractor was able to bring in the GAC vessels from their temporary storage location and be installed permanently. A subcontractor is currently working on installing the larger diameter piping prior to the metal building being installed.

The metal framework of the building is scheduled to begin to be installed the week of November 4. It is estimated to take up to three weeks to be installed and then followed by the installation of the precast wall panel and ultimately the insulated roof panels. The contractor's schedule shows the building being enclosed by the last week in December.

Below are pictures showing the progression of the construction, taken by the contractor with their drone. The last pictures are of the GAC vessels being set into place.

#### GAC MEDIA PROCUREMENT

Black & Veatch Engineers presented at the October HBPW Board Meeting on the two proposals received for supplying the initial fill GAC media and also two swing loads. The swing loads allow exhausted GAC media to be transported back to the supplier's facility to be regenerated reducing operational costs associated with continually having to purchase virgin media. The Board voted to select Calgon Carbon as the supplier and to have the Engineers and staff work on the language of the agreement to present at the November Board meeting. As can be seen in the pricing table below, the price for the initial fill and swing loads for Evoqua Water Technologies was less. However, when factoring in life cycle cost the initial price difference disappears after year three when the Calgon product becomes more cost advantageous to own. This is due to the longer time the media was shown to be effective during the rounds of pilot testing completed.
