RE: Wingnuts LLC Hangar Land Lease Extension

The City of Hannibal and Wingnuts LLC entered into a private airplane hangar lease agreement in August 1998. At the end of 20 years if both parties were in agreement the lease could extend for subsequent 5 year increments.

Currently, that agreement is up for renewal and both parties wish to extend the lease agreement for another 5 year increment.

The initial lease states that the tenant will pay the landlord (\$.10) per square foot with the hangar consisting of 8,400 square feet. This initial rate is adjusted annually on the anniversary of this lease based on the annual percentage change in the most recent Consumer Price Index. The rate for FY 2025 is \$0.1840.

The Department of Public works recommends the City Council approve another Five Year land lease extension between the City of Hannibal and Wingnuts LLC for the private hangar use at the Hannibal Regional Airport.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into a formal written agreement in order to memorialize and bind the parties to the terms and conditions of such lease, and

WHEREAS, Wingnuts wishes to extend their lease agreement dated August 4th, 1998 for an additional Five Years, as set forth in section Two of that lease for their hangar at the airport, and

WHEREAS, Wingnuts agrees to pay a fixed amount subject to annual CPI increases, for a total of 8,400 square feet of ground, and

SECTION ONE: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Hannibal, a Five Year Land Lease Extension with Wingnuts, LLC for private aviation hangar use at the Hannibal Regional Airport.

The Hannibal Emergency Management Agency was awarded a grant from the Missouri State Emergency Management Agency to purchase a replacement outdoor warning siren. The grant award for up to \$48,563.35 is a non-matching grant, which would cover the entirety of the project. The siren would replace an aging siren on Center Street at 5th Street. The new siren would have the capability to broadcast voice alerts, which would be preloaded for levee breach information.

In April, we went out for sealed bid on the project and received the following bid:
